

## Brief Biography of Prof. Chin-Shan LU, Director of ICMS



Professor Chin-Shan Lu is currently the Director of C.Y. Tung International Centre for Maritime Studies. He has good experience and track records in the shipping management and transport logistics in the world. He received his BBA and MBA in Shipping and Transportation Management from the National Taiwan Ocean University, Taiwan, and Ph.D. in Maritime Studies and International Transport from the University of Wales, Cardiff, UK. Professor Chin-Shan Lu has a good mix of academic and service experience. He started his academic career in 1997 as Assistant Professor at the Cheng Jung Christian University, Taiwan. Later, he worked at National Cheng Kung University as Assistant Professor and Associate Professor from 1998 to 2005 and got promoted to Full Professorship in 2005. During his appointment in the National Cheng Kung University, Professor Lu also acted as a chairman for the Chinese Maritime Research Institute and independent director for the Kuang Ming Shipping Corporation in Taiwan. He also has been a co-chair for the conference of International Association of Maritime Economists (IAME) in 2012.

Professor Chin-Shan Lu's recent research addresses the issues of sustainability, green shipping, safety, national culture, and dynamic capabilities in the context of shipping and port sectors. His research papers have been accepted or published in various academic journals, including *Maritime Policy and Management*, *Transportation Research Part E: Logistics and Transportation Review*, *Transportation*, *Transportation Journal*, *International Journal of Production Economics*, *Journal of Safety Research*, *Accident Analysis and Prevention*, *European Journal of Operational Research*, *International Journal of Operations and Production Management*, *Transportation Geography*, *Transportation Research Part D: Transport and Environment*, *International Journal of Shipping and Transport Logistics*, *International Journal of Logistics: Research and Applications*, as well as in related fields. He is an Associate Editor for the international journal of *Maritime Policy & Management*, Editorial Board for the *International Journal of Shipping and Transport Logistics*, Guest Editor of the special Issue for the *International Journal of Production Economics*, *Maritime Policy and Management*, *International Journal of Shipping and Transport Logistics*. He has contributed 56 articles to professional journals (include 46 ranked in SSCI/SCI journals), 87 conference papers, 36 research project reports, and 2 textbooks.
