Thomas Chung is Associate Professor at the School of Architecture, The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He graduated from the University of Cambridge, and has practiced as a registered architect in the United Kingdom. His research interest involves understanding how architecture contributes to the urban order and culture of the modern city. Thomas is active in steering, curating and exhibiting at the HK-SZ Bi-City Biennale of Urbanism \ Architecture (UABB) both in Hong Kong and Shenzhen for the past decade, as well as at the Venice Biennale in 2010 and 2014. He presently serves on the Board of Directors for the Hong Kong Architecture Centre and the UABB(HK) Steering Committee. Following his multiple award-winning projects Value Farm in UABB(SZ) 2013 and Floating Fields in UABB(SZ) 2015, Thomas is researching how ecological architecture and productive landscape design strategies can combine with socio-cultural innovation to explore alternative sustainable designs in urban development.
